

Directions to 200 Elm Street (southbound)

- Take i-95 south to Exit 8
- At the light make a right
- Make the first right into the building parking entrance

Directions to 200 Elm Street (northbound)

- Take i-95 north to Exit 8
- Go several traffic lights to Elm Street and make a left.
- After the traffic light make a right into the building parking entrance.

- Directions to 695 East Main street (southbound)
 - Take I-95S to Exit 8
 - At the next light take a right onto Elm street
 - At the next light take a right onto East Main street
 - Garage is at the end of the circular drive way
- Directions to 695 East Main street (northbound)
 - Take I-95N to Exit 8
 - take a left onto Washington Blvd
 - Take a right onto Tressor Blvd
 - Tressor Blvd becomes East Main street pass
 Elm
 - Garage is at the end of the circular driveway.

- Directions to 695 East Main street from North Stamford
 - Head southeast on Long Ridge Rd
 - Make a right on Cold Spring
 - Continue on to Washington Blvd
 - Make a left on Tressor Blvd
 - Continue on tressor to East Main street
 - Garage is at the end of the circular drive way



Driving Directions

NEW YORK CITY

From 695 East Main Lobby- Take a RIGHT out of the driveway and go 1 MILE to the McDonalds on your right-hand side. Follow the onramp signs for i95 SOUTH. New York City is approximately 35 miles and between 45 minutes to an hour away.

From Elm Street Garage – Take a RIGHT out if the parking garage. Take your first LEFT onto Tresser Boulevard. Take your second LEFT onto Atlantic Street then take your second RIGHT onto North State Street, merging onto i95 SOUTH.

NEW HAVEN

From the 695 East Main Lobby- Take a RIGHT out of the building and go 1 MILE, passing the McDonalds. Go over the bridge above i95 and on your right is the ramp for i95 NORTH. New Haven is approximately 48 miles away and takes up t o an hour or more depending on the Norwalk traffic.

From Elm Street Garage – Turn RIGHT out of the garage and go to the intersection. Take a RIGHT onto East Main Street and go 1 MILE, passing the McDonalds. Go over the bridge above i95 and on your right is the ramp for i95 NORTH. New Haven is approximately 48 miles away and takes up to an hour or more depending on the Norwalk traffic.
